










# Horse riding trail

The horse trail crosses other trails and some sections are shared with cyclists, walkers and runners. Please be aware of other visitors.

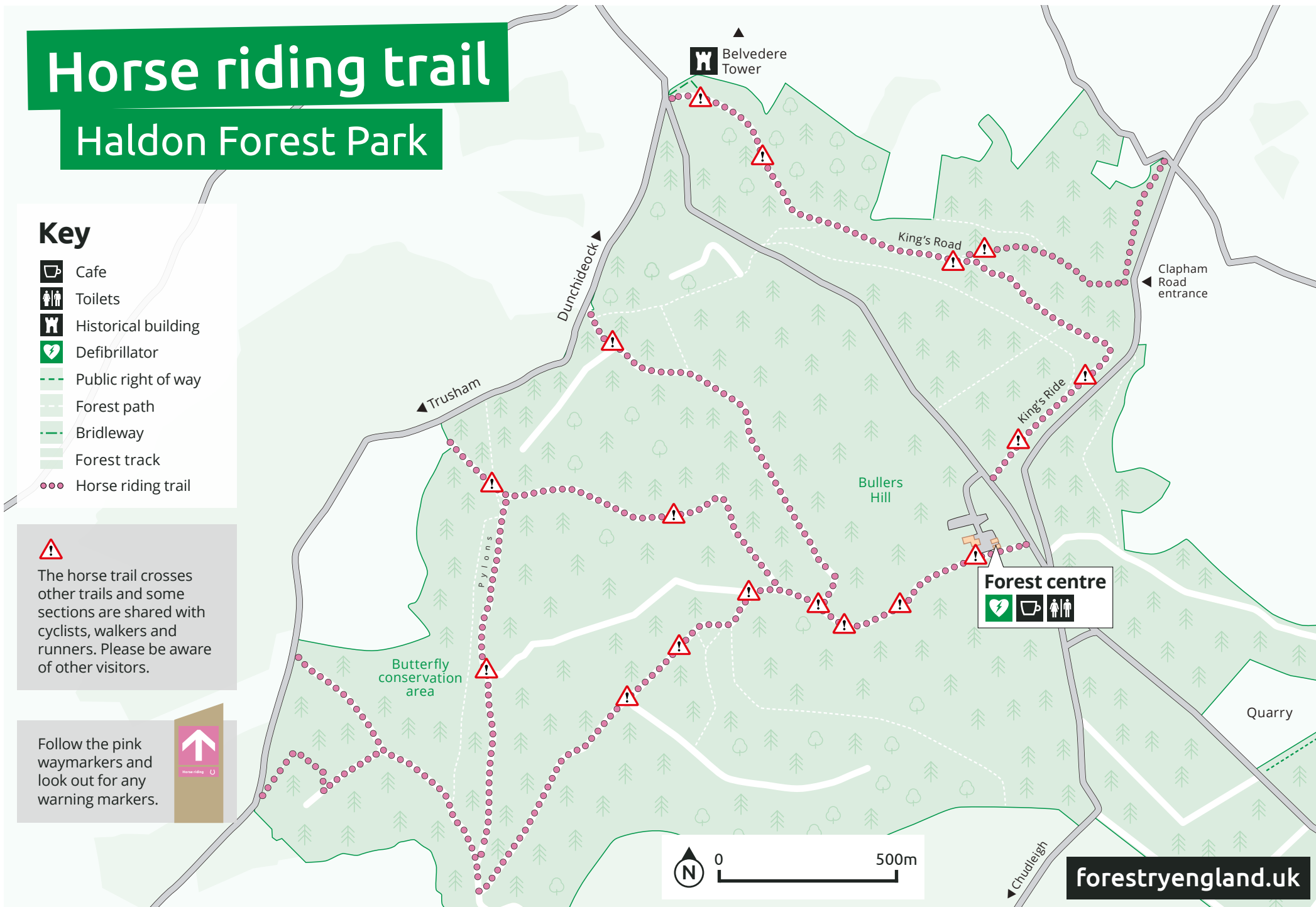
Follow the pink waymarkers and look out for any warning markers.
